

Information and Criteria for Scholarships:

Wyoming Wool Growers Auxiliary Scholarship - \$300

Joy Hardy Memorial Scholarship - \$300

****Cindy Innes Memorial Scholarship - \$1000 (\$500 per semester)**

****Ronald Innes Memorial Scholarship - \$1000 (\$500 per semester)**

1. Applicants must be a Wyoming resident and have lived in their attendance area their entire high school Senior year. Applicants may be students currently attending a qualified post high school institution.

2. Scholarships are available for students planning to attend any college, university or accredited trade school program. Scholarships are not available for correspondence courses.

3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of individual applications. Each application must be completed and submitted to WWG Auxiliary, P. O. Box 115, Casper WY 82601 by **April 15**. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered. Selection of scholarship recipients shall be made by the Scholarship Committee. Decisions of this committee shall be final.

* Final selection of the Joy Hardy Memorial Scholarship shall remain with Gene Hardy.

* Final selection for Cindy & Ronald Innes Memorial Scholarships shall remain with Bob Innes.

4. Applications for scholarships will be considered equally without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, religion, political belief, or disability.

5. All applicants must submit **ONE completed official application, essay, official transcript, and two (2) letters of recommendation.** **Additional requirements are below for Innes Scholarships.**

6. Applicants shall be judged on their community and school involvement, merit of the student and financial need with preference given to those who choose a major in the College of Agriculture or have an agriculture background.

7. Scholarships will be awarded as a one-time payment to the recipient upon graduation from high school and verification of post high school enrollment, or as specified by the individual donor.

8. Students applying for scholarships must have a minimum of a 2.50 GPA.

**** Both Innes Scholarships:** Consideration will be given to a graduating senior or to a student who is currently attending a college, university or accredited trade school program. The applicant must submit a one-page essay on your belief in Agriculture. Please specify how you will be involved in agriculture in the future, your knowledge of Agriculture and your dedication to the Ag Industry. The applicant does NOT have to be enrolled in the College of Agriculture.
